

## Q-marks Paper Pieced Bookmarks by Patti R. Anderson

Amish Bookmark -- 2 1/2" x 7"  
Finished Block Size -- 2"

### Fabrics:

- scraps of various solids, including black
- black solid: 3" x 8" rectangle,  
two 3/4" x 2 1/2" strips for sashings  
22" strip for binding (width  
depends on the binding method  
you choose)

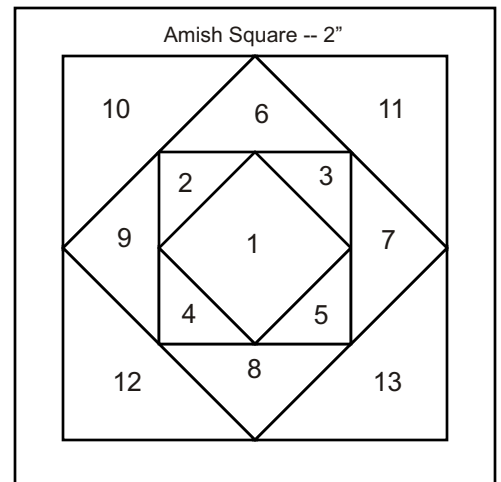
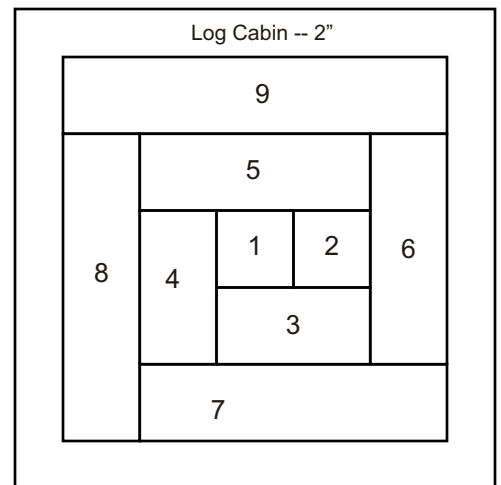
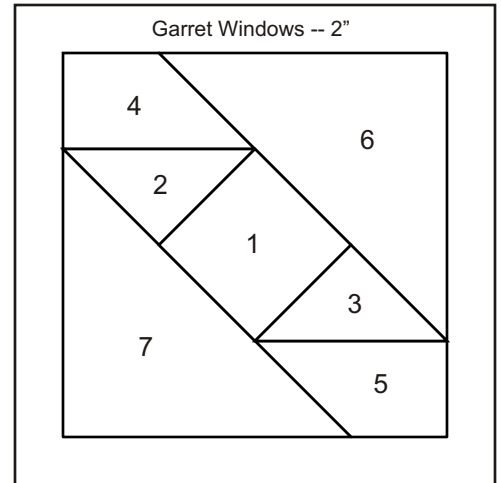
### Supplies:

- fusible webbing (sewable type) Cut a  
rectangle just slightly smaller than the  
bookmark.
- thread to match

### Instructions:

\*\*Seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.

1. Paper piece the blocks (leave the paper on until the sashing seam is sewn)
2. Sew the black sashings strips between the blocks. Trim seam allowances to 1/8". Remove paper. Press.
3. Iron the fusible webbing to the bookmark and remove paper backing.
4. Lay the black rectangle for the backing, wrong side up and fuse the bookmark to it. Trim backing even with bookmark.
5. Bind in black solid, using your favorite method.



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
